- 4. How has the candidate been recognised by fellow colleagues as an inspiration, mentor and leader during their career.**
- 5. How has the candidate contributed to global conservation and ranger initiatives**

A summary of the nomination of no more than 350 words must be provided.

Low resolution photos clearly labelled with the applicant name and award title may be uploaded here or be sent to the email addresses below to compliment the application.

The winning nomination will receive funds to meet the reasonable travel and accommodation costs for the award recipient to attend the IUCN World Parks Congress 2014 to receive their award at a dedicated ceremony.

All applications are encouraged to attach any additional media formats in support of the nomination. Links and files (under 2MB) to support the criteria

English is the preferred application language however other languages will be considered.

The IRF reserves the right to use any part of the supplied application provided by nominees, however, this will be done in consultation with the nominees as not to compromise sensitive information.

The successful candidate will be notified by August 31 World Ranger Day

The decision of the IRF committee is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.

All nominees must have valid passports and be able and willing to travel to the Congress.
