- 1. Thin Green Line Foundation (TGLF) grants directly to Game Rangers Association of Africa (GRAA) to support the IRF Executive Officer. Annual grant paid semi-annually.
 - AUD 30,000 funding for October 2020 to October 2021.
 - AUD 15,000 to extend the position funding to March 2022.
 - AUD 15,000 to extend position to September 2022.
- 2. USD 61,000 from Re:wild (RW) (formerly Global Wildlife Conservation) for:
 - USD 36,000 for IRF Federation Development Officer from May 2021 to May 2022.
