The 5th European Ranger Congress took place at a time of uncertainty after having to deal with a worldwide pandemic, war within Europe and increasing ramifications of climate change and biodiversity losses.

The work of Rangers all over Europe is getting more and more crucial and still not less complicated.

At the 5th European Ranger Congress more than 100 rangers from all over Europe discussed the current situation and potential fields of activity for the European Ranger Federation.

The following actions have been identified during work on the congress and are being assigned to the executive committee of the ERF:

1. establishing an European Ranger Image and strengthen public relations with strong regard to the ideas and notions of the national ranger associations
2. establish guidelines for fundraising
3. proceed in the Training program for European Rangers
4. establishing guidelines to support trainers, trainings and twinning programs Europe wide by assignment of the ERF
5. involve European ranger interests in international organizations and always promote cooperation, friendship and working together on eye-level
6. improve flow of information from ERF and IRF directly to the field rangers of Europe and vice versa while promoting ERF-instagram, ERF-newsletter, etc.
7. encourage every ranger to improve flow of information like distributing news of ERF in their countries/associations
8. establish criteria (checklist) for hosts of European Ranger Congresses that outline in detail what requirements exist concerning venue, financial borders, etc.
9. provide national associations with knowledge, materials and all kinds of direct or indirect support resulting from the empowered financial means of the ERF
