The Award

The *International Ranger Federation Lifetime Achievement Award* is presented on an three yearly basis to an individual who has been involved in a career relating to the conservation, preservation, promotion and/or protection of the natural environment especially those whose actions have positively impacted Rangers*.

Selection Criteria

This award is open to any person with a role related to conservation, at any level whether it be grassroots or management level, who has not previously been awarded.

The successful candidate must have shown a great capacity for achieving conservation goals throughout their career in the conservation and preservation of cultural and natural assets.

*A Ranger is defined as a person involved in the practical protection and preservation of all aspects of wild areas, historical and cultural sites. Rangers provide recreational opportunities and interpretation of sites while providing links between local communities, protected areas and area administration.

Then briefly outline the following:

- The candidate's career, appointments and highlights.
- The awards, achievements and/or recognition the candidate has received as a result of their efforts.
- The changes and/or results the candidate has achieved and gained notoriety for.
- If the candidate has been recognised by fellow colleagues as an inspiration, mentor and leader during their career.
- How has the candidate contributed to global conservation and Ranger initiatives?

A summary of the nomination of no more than 350 words must be provided.
